The Li's garden alongside each other and friends three days a week growing tomato's peppers and various greens. The Li's speak only Mandarin and have found the garden to be a place where language knows no boundaries and they are able to share tips and growing information with friends of all ethnicities. The elderly clients at GGNC like Mr. Li and his wife enjoy almost six months of gardening each year in 33 plots right on the GGNC grounds.
