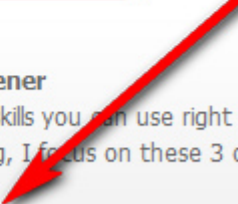
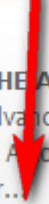
By doing the above, every time you post a blog or recipe to the KGI site, an author box will appear at the bottom of each of your contributed posts:
