## Growing Heirloom Lemon Cucumbers

This is my first year growing lemon cucumbers and boy are they delicious. They are very crisp and sweet. They are small and round, about 3 1/2 inches long, and well worth the effort to grow. They turn a lemon-lime color with yellow stripes when mature. They are great in summer salads and because of their thin skins they make great pickles.

They are native to India and have been growing for three thousand years. In 1494 Christopher Columbus introduced them to Haiti and then soon after they were introduced to North America.

Cucumbers are a warm weather vegetable so sow after the last frost, directly into the garden. Thin to 12 inches in a row or plant three plants per mound every 36 inches. To save space, you can train cucumbers to grow up a trellis or a fence.

Lemon cucumbers will mature in 65 days.
